

Department of Defense Tuition Assistance - Cost Per Credit Hour by School

The Department of Defense requires all institutions using a **flat rate** for tuition to post the cost per credit hour rate on their website in order for our active military students to receive the tuition assistance benefit. Below is the cost per credit rate for each Harvard school for masters and undergraduate programs. Please note that the figures below are provided solely to meet this requirement as Harvard does not use a cost per credit hour calculation to determine tuition charges. The rate is calculated based on credits or units for your program and your school's tuition rate. This amount will not be posted with your school's Cost of Attendance.

* Graduate School of Education - M = Master Program and C = Certificate Program. Degree requirements stipulate that all Master students are to be charged for at least 42 credits and Certificate students are to be charged for at least 32 credits at full-time student tuition rate. Students may take a maximum of 56 credits during their degree at no additional charge. There is no charge for audited courses.
